#### **Meeting Minutes**

## 1) General Business and Updates

- NMSU EP is now fully ABET accredited (no more concerns or weaknesses)
- Internal updates on the self-study reports (SSR) are typically due in June of each year
- Kyle will continue to be in charge for outcomes assessment

## 2) New EP Options

- Two new options: Aerospace and Chemical
- Need advertising; press releases (de Antonio will look into that)
- Outcomes assessment matrices for new options (Kyle will check)

## 3) EP Advisory Board Meeting

- April would be preferred, but exact dates depend on Jim McNeil and Mark Schraad (Advisory Board Chair)
- Need representatives for new options; Chemical, Aerospace; Nakotte will contact board members

#### 4) Recruitment and Retention, Website

- Enrollment is up; now 28 EP students (from ~15 a year ago); past efforts paid off; strong incoming freshman class (average ACT score: 26)
- Retention has become a major issue (especially for juniors); need to consider possible curriculum changes; Pate suggests to add Vasiliev (the Curriculum Committee chair) to the EP committee
- Recruitment opportunities: ILC presentations (Nov. 10, 12, 17 and 19), Aggie Experience; Kyle, Nakotte and Pate will attend
- Website is no longer up-to-date; Re-hiring of Fernandez (past webmaster and EP recruitment coordinator) should be considered; Nakotte will ask Department Head
- Need more social events for students; Pizza lunches etc.

#### 5) Other Business

- DeAntonio suggested a future EP Photonics option, together with EE;
  discussion was postponed to next meeting
